

Tooth Brushing

Corbets Tey School run a daily supervised tooth brushing programme. This follows Department of Health advice that recommend programmes in nurseries and schools. Brushing with fluoride toothpaste will not only help to reduce the possibility of your child developing tooth decay, it will also help keep your child's gums healthy. This is important as they help support the teeth. Toothbrushes and toothpaste will be supplied and the brushes will be changed regularly. They will be marked so that each child's brush can be identified, and they will be stored hygienically in suitable containers. The Special Care and Community Dental Service will monitor the programme and offer support to school staff to enable this programme to be effective.
