The School Day

The School Day is structured as follows:

8.55am	Start of the Day
10.30am	Break
10.45am	Break Ends
12.00pm	Lunch
1.00pm	Lunch Ends
1.00pm	Assembly Wednesday (Primary) Thursday (Secondary) Monday, Tuesday, Friday (Exercise Time/Singing/Signing Assemblies/Acts of Worship
1.30pm	Assembly/Exercise Ends
3.20pm	End of School Day

If you are bringing your child to school and collecting them at the end of the day, the car park is very busy between 8.30 and 8.55am and 3.05pm and 3.20pm.

We advise parents to avoid these times particularly in the afternoon and suggest that children are collected at 2.45pm – 3.00pm

Snacks

Some classes will ask you for a weekly voluntary contribution to cover snacks and drinks. Snack time in classes can be used as an opportunity to introduce new foods when necessary and therefore provide a wide range of both food and drinks including squashes and milk shakes, fruit, cheese, yoghurts and the occasional biscuit and crisps. Your class teacher will advise you if a contribution is requested in your child's class.

Clothes

We ask all parents to send a set of spare clothes just in case! In addition they will need a P.E. kit which will remain in school and be sent home each holiday for washing — please see uniform list for details. Once each week the children will take part in swimming sessions. Please send in a swimming kit on that day and it will be returned after the session. Reception children will also need a raincoat/kagool and wellingtons which can remain in school. We would be grateful to receive a donated pack of wet wipes and tissues from all parents each term if possible. Parents whose children use nappies are ask to send a pack of nappies and we will inform you when we need more.
