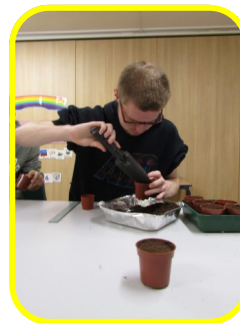
Oxford Street
