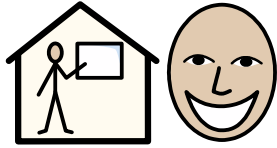


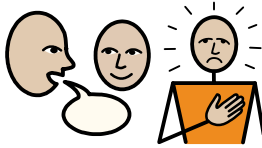
Anti-Bullying Policy - Easy Read

Sometimes people can say things that make other people feel sad



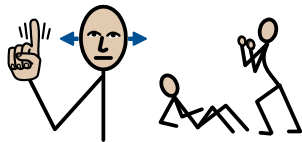
Sometimes people can hurt others



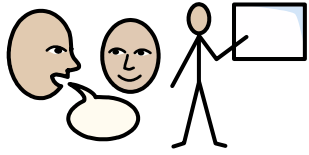
Sometimes people can touch or get too close to others when they don't want them to

If you feel someone is bullying you, you should tell a teacher or another adult



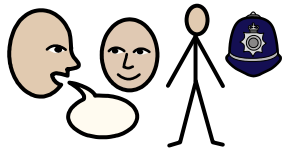
The headteacher will decide if the person who has upset you has done anything wrong



The person who has upset you might be asked to say sorry



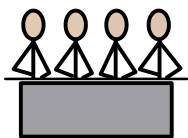
The other person should change their behaviour
