Free School Meals During the School Holidays

Following on from the Free Schools Meal funding support provided to families during the October half term, the Borough will continue to provide support to families during the Christmas holidays and February half term via the government's Winter Grant scheme. Families who are eligible for welfare benefit related free school meals will receive £30.00 per child for the December holiday period and £15.00 per child for the February half-term holiday. This will ensure that those children eligible for free school meals do not go hungry during the holidays.

The Borough will administer the scheme and the December application window will open on Monday 30 November, closing on Friday 11 December. Families who received a payment for the October half term do not need to reapply and will automatically receive the funds. Please contact the school office if you are entitled to Free School Meals and may not have taken advantage of this opportunity in October.

Amazon Smile

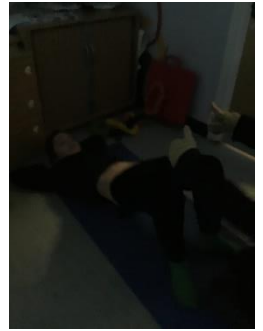
